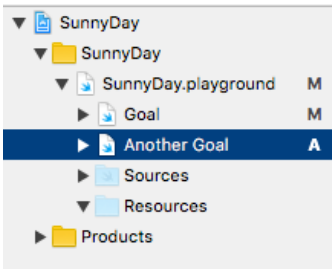


# Using Source Control to Save Versions of Your Work

“Commit” a file to add to the repository that stores work on your local computer



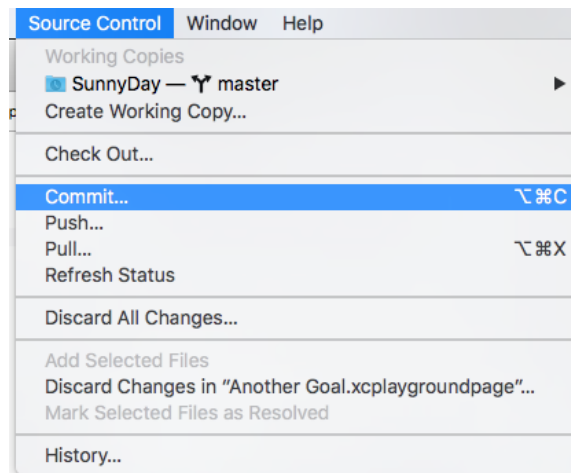
“Push” your commits to save them on [GitHub.com](https://github.com) (this is key!)



The “M” means that a file has been modified since your last commit.

An “A” means that a file has been newly added and has not yet been committed.

To commit, choose this menu sequence in Xcode:



As shown below, you will see a commit sheet. Write a description of what you accomplished (1) then be sure to check the “Push to remote” box (2) and finally press the “Commit” button (3).
